



Pace Route 465 (Belmont Station – Esplanade Shuttle Bug)

- Connects Esplanade to Metra's Belmont Station (BNSF).
- Meets 4 outbound AM trains from Downtown Chicago and 1 inbound AM train from Aurora.
- Meets 3 inbound PM trains to Downtown Chicago and 1 outbound PM train to Aurora.
- Makes morning and evening stops at the same 3 locations in Esplanade (3250/3131 Building, 1901/2001 Building and 3500 Lacey Road). Look for "Pace Route 465" bus stop signs.

Riding Pace Route 465

- Employees with an employer-issued Ventra® Card receive unlimited rides on Pace Route 465 (\$1.75 each way otherwise).
- You can sign up with your Office Manager or HR Department to receive an employer-issued Ventra Card for use on Pace Route 465.
- When boarding the bus, touch your employer-issued Ventra Card to the yellow target on the card reader. Go when you see the green "Go."
- You must purchase a ticket to ride Metra to/from Belmont Station.
- For your evening commute, arrive at your bus stop a few minutes before the scheduled bus arrival time.



Planning Your Commute

- Use the RTA Trip Planner at RTAChicago.org or call 630-836-7000 for step-by-step transit directions.
- Real-time bus and train trackers for Pace and Metra are available at RTAChicago.org.
- You can also get real-time information on Pace Route 465 by text message. Type "41411" as the phone number and in the body of the message, type "Pace", then a space, then the code number you see on the bus stop sign. For example, "Pace 35825".
- Sign up for email updates about this route by visiting the Route 465 route page at PaceBus.com and clicking on the button with an envelope on it.



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How do I sign up for the free shuttle?

A: Contact your Office Manager or HR Department to sign up and receive an employer-issued Ventra Card.

Q: What is Ventra?

A: Ventra is the contactless fare payment system used by Pace and CTA. For more information on Ventra, please visit ventrachicago.com

Q: How do I pay for my ride?

A: Employees with an employer-issued Ventra Card receive unlimited rides on Pace Route 465. If you do not have an employer-issued Ventra Card, the fare is \$1.75 and can be paid by cash, transit value or a pass loaded onto a Ventra Card or a contactless bankcard.

Q: Can I pay for my Metra ride using my employer-issued Ventra Card?

A: No. Metra does not currently accept Ventra.

Q: What do I do if I lose my employer-issued Ventra Card?

A: You should contact your Office Manager or HR Department as soon as possible if you have lost your employer-issued Ventra Card.

Q: What do I do if my employer-issued Ventra Card does not work?

A: You should contact your Office Manager or HR Department if your employer-issued Ventra Card does not work.

Q: Where can I purchase a Metra ticket?

A: Metra tickets may be purchased at the downtown stations, at outlying stations where a ticket agent is on duty, through vending machines, by internet and by mail. Where no ticket agent or vending machine exists, you may board the train and purchase a one-way, cash-fare ticket from the conductor. However, if an agent is on duty or a vending machine is available, and you elect to purchase the ticket on the train, the conductor will charge an additional \$3. Q: How can I use pre-tax money to buy my Metra ticket?

A: You should contact your Office Manager or HR Department to find out if your company offers pre-tax transit benefits. Learn more about RTA's Transit Benefit Fare Program at mytransitbenefit.com.

A: The BNSF Railway serves the 26 stations between Chicago Union Station and Aurora Station listed below:

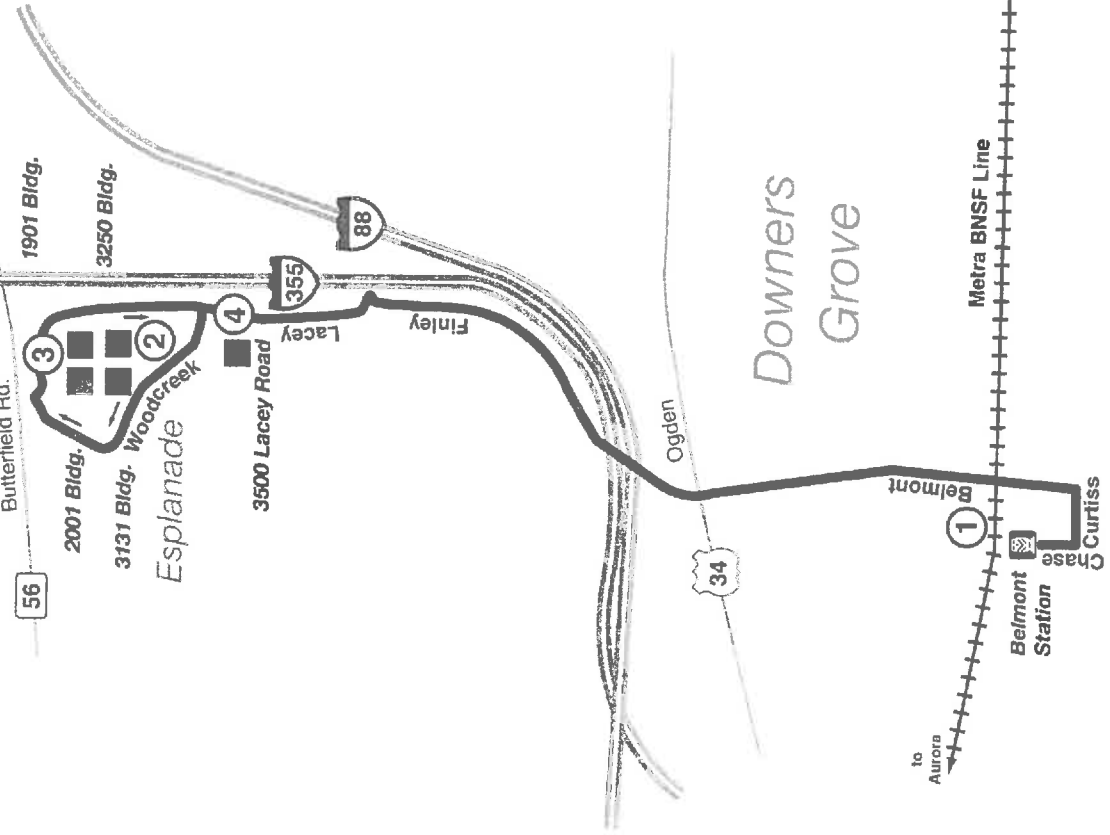

Customers may use a Ventra Card, contactless bankcard, Ticket, Ride Free or Reduced Fare permit, or cash to pay fares on Pace fixed route services. Reduced fares are available for children (ages 7-11) and high school, junior high and grammar school students (ages 12-20) presenting a valid Ventra Student Riding Permit or valid school I.D. between 5:30am and 8:30pm on school days. Seniors 65 and older, people with disabilities and individuals with a valid Medicare card qualify for reduced fares. A valid RTA Reduced Fare Permit must be presented when using cash to pay a reduced fare. Eligible seniors and people with disabilities may ride fixed route services for free through the RTA Ride Free Program. Please contact the RTA at 836-7000 for more information on free and reduced fares. Free rides are offered to children under 7 (max two children per fare paying adult), law enforcement officers and firefighters in full uniform or presenting a badge, and active duty military personnel in uniform. See the Pace Fare Guide for current fares, passes, restrictions and additional information. Visit ventrachicago.com or call 877-NOW-VENTRA to purchase and load value and passes onto your Ventra Card.

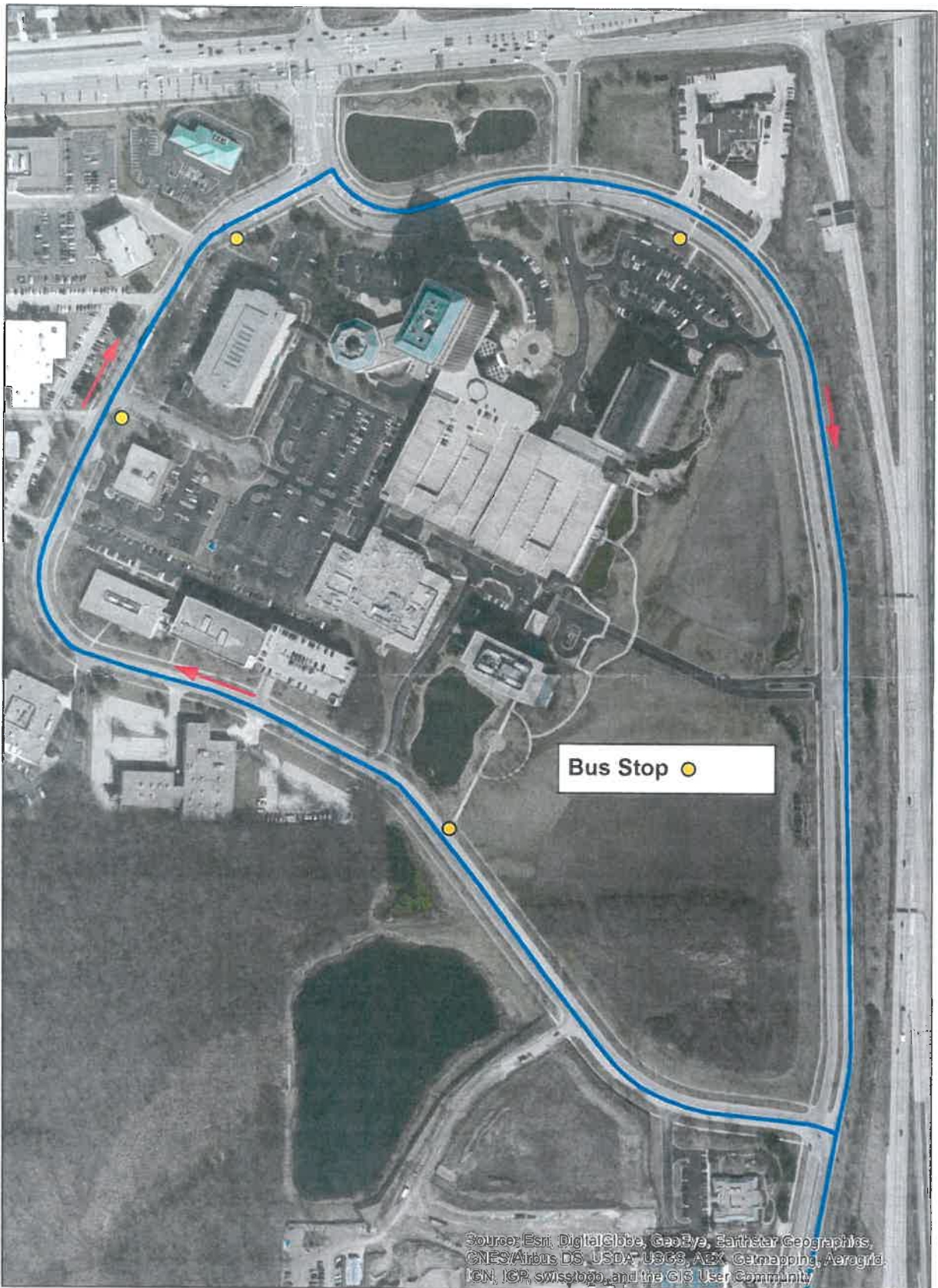
